GRE information for Oregon MPH applicants: Change in scoring

The new GRE went into effect on August 1, 2011. The GRE's scoring scale will change from reporting scores on a scale from 200-800 to a scale from 130-170. In November 2011, a GRE conversion scale will be released, so then we will know exactly how the new scale can be compared to the old scale.

The GRE General Test must have been taken within 5 years of application to the MPH program, so if an applicant's score is within this time frame, the old scores are acceptable.
